**CONSENT CALENDAR**

Update on *Epiphany*

John Hartung, Community Library Network Director, reported back to the Commission on bollard pricing. Bollards installed for the Post Falls library project were \$987 for one bollard. He stated that the Library Facilities Manager can get more quotes if needed. He went on to say that there is some curbing in front of *Epiphany* but there is a gap because the snow plows tear it up. He thinks the concrete base of *Epiphany* should suffice against most vehicles since it is 18 inches tall. The Commission discussed whether or not to put in a bollard and Vice-Chair Sorensson made a motion to put the bollard discussion on hold. Commissioner Havens seconded.
