Call to Order: Chair Eichelberger called the meeting to order at 5:08 pm.

Roll Call of Commission Members: Chair Eichelberger, Vice-Chair Bennett, Commissioner Master are present. Commissioner Boston is absent. We have a quorum.

Flag Salute: The flag salute was led by Chair Eichelberger.

1. **Consent Calendar**

- a. Motion to approve the regular meeting minutes of May 11, 2017 by Vice-Chair Bennett and seconded by Commissioner Masters. Minutes approved.

2. **Unfinished Business**

- a. Hayden History Book Volume II Recap – Vice-Chair Bennett has been taking a sabbatical. Working on the Bests, Burns, and Pullman.
- b. Hayden History Book Volume I Update - Chair Eichelberger pointed out that the commissioners had the first 38 families edited by Linda Mitcham.
- c. Oral History Workshop Update – the class was cancelled that Chair Eichelberger had planned on attending. Ms. Krueger suggested that she reach out to her friend that had worked for the Wenatchee Museum and a radio station. What kinds of questions should be asked?
 - i. Identify individuals to Interview – who are people that Vice-Chair Bennett has interviewed for the book that would be good story tellers. Walt Sims, Burt Rorhbach, etc.
 - ii. Lake City High School Teacher to participate – Eric Edmonds spoke to him regarding the cameras and audio equipment for the interviews.
- d. Steele Cabin Update – Chair Eichelberger said that she had left some messages for Janeen regarding the passing of time and the ability to move the cabin. Ms. Krueger shared some 2017 photos that were taken of the existing setting and the donated farm implements. The City is working on the site planning and staff would like to know the direction of the Commission with respect to rotation of the various objects for display. Additionally it was suggested that the Commission identify an era to accept farm implements donations. Although it is not an issue today, the City only has a certain amount of storage space. Commissioner Masters asked if there was power and water available to the cabin, as cabins of this time frame would include a clothesline, a privy, and a bell. Sadly, the City received a letter from the Coeur d'Alene Tribe that said that we did not receive a grant to move the cabin. The letter said to talk to them late in the summer to apply again.
- e. Budget Request Update – Ms. Krueger stated that it has been submitted to the City Council and so far it has not had any controversy.
- f. Chomper's Evening Social - Possibly on September 11, 2017: Chair Eichelberger met with Sara and asked if she wanted some new pictures. Who are the people that would be good interviews? Invite specific folks from the book to participate as a beginning point.
