**SPECIAL MEETING**

**CALL TO ORDER:** Chair Troxel called the meeting to order at 5:19 p.m.

**ROLL CALL OF COMMISSION MEMBERS:** Chair Troxel, Vice-Chair Sampsel, Commissioners Turner and Bierman were present. Commissioner Spendlove joined the meeting at 5:30 p.m.

**1. NEW BUSINESS**

**A. Dog Park Grant Discussion**


Suzie Cano mentioned that the \$10K Dog Grant is no longer available. There are five grants at \$5K each that are available. Several items are needed in order to submit the grant application. One being the executive summary which details the commission's thoughts on why the grant is needed. The deadline to submit the application is June 30. Suzie mentioned that we have the blueprints of Pawfoot Park but are in need of a summary of how the community will benefit from the grant. Photos are also needed. Commissioner Bierman will take the lead on writing the summary and will email staff. Suzie mentioned that a letter from a civic leader is also needed. She will speak with Brett Boyer, City Administrator, on who he thinks would be best to obtain the letter from, i.e., Mayor or possibly the Chamber of Commerce. Need to also show support of our community, for instance Hayden City Council, Petstop, Eagle Scouts, etc. Chair Troxel may contact the Humane Society to obtain information regarding the number of dogs that are in Hayden. The commission is to bring ideas of what amenities they would like at Pawfoot Park to the next meeting. Commissioner Bierman stressed that the placement of amenities is crucial. Some amenities may include: Bridge (ramp), tubes, poles where the dogs weave in and out.

**B. Frisbee Golf Discussion**

Vice-Chair Sampsel spoke of the proposed Frisbee Golf site at Broadmoore Park and viewed Erin (Makka) Johnson's website: [www.usydga.com](http://www.usydga.com). Makka has 33 youth teams in the Spokane schools and is in the middle of building 5 youth parks. He would like to see a youth Frisbee Golf Course in the Coeur d'Alene area. He will do an onsite layout in approximately 4 weeks at Broadmoore Park to see if it would be feasible to have approximately 5-6 holes. Each hole costs approximately \$900. There was discussion regarding sponsorships for each hole. The commission agrees that a committee should be created for the sponsorship process. Commissioner Turner discussed the possibility of setting up a pop-up course at various schools to gain popularity. Will possibly do a special meeting in June at Broadmoore Park for site plan discussion. Vice-Chair Sampsel would like a layout of Broadmoore Park including irrigation layout for planning meeting.

**2. ADJOURNMENT**

Commissioner Bierman made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 5:55 p.m. Vice-Chair Sampsel provided the second and the meeting was adjourned.
