CALL TO ORDER: Chair Troxel called the meeting to order at 5:06 p.m.

ROLL CALL OF COMMISSION MEMBERS: Chair Troxel, Vice-Chair Sampsel and Commissioners Spendlove and Turner were present. Commissioners Lile and Bierman were absent.

FLAG SALUTE: Chair Troxel led the Pledge of Allegiance.

ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS TO THE AGENDA: There were none.

1. CONSENT CALENDAR

A. Approval of Minutes of August 16, 2017

Vice-Chair Sampsel made a motion to approve the minutes of August 16, 2017; motion was seconded by Commissioner Spendlove. Motion approved.

3. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A. Bike Rack Committee Update

Chair Troxel hasn't heard back from NIC regarding the bike racks. If the commission decides to go commercial, she has a bid. Anne Abrams with the Hayden Lake Library might be interested in going in together to save on shipping costs.

B. Discuss the possibility of installing Frisbee Golf, Horseshoes, etc. at local parks

The two parks being discussed are Broadmoore Park and Stoddard Park. Suzie Cano will ask the Parks Department if there are Horseshoe pits at Broadmoore Park. The members agree that Frisbee Golf would be great at Broadmoore Park. Suzie doesn't feel that it would be too expensive. Holes can possibly be sponsored to help offset the costs. Commissioner Turner said that plaques could possibly be placed by each hole with the sponsor's name. Suzie thinks it would cost approximately \$300. Creating a league might be an option and there are also clubs in the area. Commissioner Turner feels the need to have an expert look at the park and plan it out to see if it would work. Suzie mentioned that when bids are done, that is when the companies will see if it might work. Chair Troxel asked whether a subcommittee should be created for this. It was decided that Vice-Chair Sampsel, Commissioner Turner along with Commissioner Spendlove will lead this idea. Chair Troxel spoke of the north end of Stoddard Park and ideas for that area include bocce ball, volleyball or possibly tennis courts. A rebound wall would be needed for tennis. The majority of the cost to build a tennis court at the north end of Stoddard Park would be for the installation, not the maintenance fees. Chair Troxel asked about impact fees and Suzie mentioned she will check on them. Chair Troxel will speak at the next City Council meeting and let them know of the commission's thoughts. Frisbee Golf and Tennis Court discussion will continue at the next meeting.
