Hayden City Base Budget Increase

TO AUTHORIZE AND EMPOWER THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAYDEN, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, TO INCREASE THE BASE BUDGET

Shall the City Council of the City of Hayden, Kootenai County, Idaho, be authorized and empowered to increase the base budget from property tax revenues from \$1,478,930 to \$3,111,930, a difference of \$1,633,000 as permitted by law in Section 63-802(1)(g), Idaho Code, to begin in the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019, and becoming the new base budget amount thereafter, said increase to provide for the general road and law enforcement needs of the City of Hayden, Kootenai County, Idaho?

The purpose for which the \$1,633,000 increase to the base budget from property tax revenues shall be used is to pay all lawful expenses related to maintaining and providing for the general road and law enforcement needs of the City of Hayden, Idaho. The amount estimated to be collected with the new base budget amount is \$3,111,930 per year.
