REGISTRATION

The Recreation & Community Events Department Administrative Office is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. We accept cash, checks, Visa & MC. Registration for programs can be done; (1) Online for a small convenience fee of \$2.75 at http://haydencommunityservices.sportsites.com/player/homeplayer.aspx (2) In person at the Hayden Recreation & Community Events Department located at Hayden City Hall (3) Mailing registrations with a check to Hayden Recreation & Community Events Department, 8930 N. Government Way, Hayden, ID. 83835 (4) Completing the registration form, enclosing your payment, and putting it in the drop-box located in front of Hayden City Hall. A confirmation along with program information will then be emailed to you.

GENERAL POLICIES

- All fees must be paid at the time of registration to ensure your participation. No discounts for times missed during vacations or illness.
- The Hayden Recreation & Community Events Department reserves the right to make changes in schedules, fees, and instructors without notice. We also reserve the right to cancel or combine classes if minimum registration is not met.
- If games, practices or classes are called off due to circumstances beyond our control (weather, school district mandated, etc.) the Hayden Recreation
 Community Events Department may or may not reschedule canceled games/practices/classes.
- We appreciate our sponsors but please be advised that no politically affiliated sponsorships can be accepted.
- Children cannot be placed in a division with children more than two years older than him/her.

REFUND POLICY

- The Recreation & Community Events Department requires minimum levels of enrollment to be met in order to run classes. If a class or program is canceled due to lack of enrollment, you will be notified and given a full refund.
- An 80% refund will be made if a participant withdraws from a Special Interest Program prior to the first class. Withdrawal from a program after classes have begun will result in a 80% refund, minus the cost for the class attended. No refund will be given after the second class.
- Refunds for Outdoors Programs are subject to program specifications.
- An 80% refund will be made if a participant withdraws from a Sports League before the Parents/Coaches meetings. Withdraw or notice after
 preseason meetings will result in no refund.

FEE POLICY

Residents who live outside of the city limits of Hayden are encouraged to participate in all programs; however, fees for "non-residents" are a little higher than those for "residents" for many of our programs and classes. Non-residents do not pay property taxes that support City services. Boundaries used by the Post Office, the School District, and the Fire District are not the same as city-limit boundaries, although you may have a Hayden mailing address, you may be considered a non-resident. If you need help determining whether you live inside or outside the city limits please call our office at 209-1080, or stop in and view our city zoning map.

SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

A waiver of fees may be available for youth programs listed in this brochure if a request is made based on need. Funds come through a grant from the Ford Ironman Coeur d'Alene Community Fund and public donations, so please let us know if you're interested in providing a scholarship for someone in need. SPECIALIZED NEEDS RECREATION

Specialized Needs Recreation is a non-profit organization that offers recreational programs for youth and adults who have trouble participating in other programs because of a learning disability, sensory impairment, mental, emotional, or physical handicap. SNR provides the SNR LIFE Program for ages 16 on up. SNR also provides participants of all ages, 5-10 monthly activities these activities consist of monthly theme dances, bingo nights, cooking classes, basketball, pizza nights, trips the arena, Club SNR, Annual Talent Shows, Prom Nights and Christmas Party. For youth ages 4-21 SNR provides Camp All-Stars summer, winter, spring break and school-off day camps from 9:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. daily during school breaks. SNR provides scholarships to over half of our campers throughout the year. SNR provides scholarships for low income families for Camp, transportation to and from all events and trained staff and volunteers to assist in the participants in having fun and helping them build lasting relationships.

HAYDEN PARKS & FIELDS

- ♦ BROADMOORE PARK: Broadmoore Park is a ten-acre neighborhood park located within the Broadmoore Subdivision off of Atlas Road. *Amenities*: tot lot, walking path, water fountains, passive ball field
- CROFFOOT PARK & SPORTS COMPLEX: Croffoot Park and Sports Complex is located on Lancaster Avenue west of Highway 95. This complex encompasses 25 pristine acres and has a wonderful vista of both mountain and prairie.
