ABOUT THE COMMISSION:

Historic Preservation Commission Members participate in identifying, evaluating, designating and protecting the buildings, sites, districts, areas, structures, and objects that reflect the city, state, and the nation's historic, architectural, archaeological, and cultural heritage. Some duties and responsibilities of a commission member would include:

- Conduct surveys of local historical properties.
- Make recommendations regarding the acquisition of historical property.
- Recommend methods and procedures necessary to preserve, restore, maintain, and operate historic properties under the ownership and control of the City.
- Promote and conduct educational and interpretive programs on historic preservation and historic properties in the City.
- Review nominations of properties to the National Register of Historic Places for properties within the City's jurisdiction.



MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- City of Hayden Resident.
- Ability to attend regular meetings.
- Ability to communicate effectively and form positive working relationships with others.
- Willingness and ability to work cooperatively with other commission members, city staff, and the public to achieve the goals of the commission.
