ABOUT THE COMMISSION:

Planning and Zoning Commission members participate in making recommendations to our City Council regarding land use decisions through a quasi-judicial process. Some of the duties and responsibilities of a commission member include:

- Attend regular meetings.
- Review and provide input on ordinances related to land use and development.
- Review land use requests such as subdivisions and annexations with regard to Comprehensive Plan and City ordinances.
- Make recommendations to City Council regarding land use decisions.
- Serve in an advisory capacity for long-range planning and community development issues.



MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Ability to attend regular meetings.
- Ability to communicate effectively and form positive working relationships with others.
- Willingness and ability to work cooperatively with other commission members, city staff, and the public to achieve the goals of the commission.
- Must reside within the boundaries of the City of Hayden.
